



Supplementary Figure 6. Forest plot of adjusted risk ratio by treatment arm for the clinical and angiographic outcomes stratified by vessel occlusion site. Clinical outcomes (mRS 0–1 and mRS 0–2) were adjusted for age, sex, baseline stroke severity, stroke symptom onset-to-needle time as fixed-effects variables, and site as a random-effects variable. Angiographic outcomes were adjusted for age as fixed-effects variable, and site as a random-effects variable. *P* values for interaction were not significant for all outcomes (*P*>0.05). Adjusted risk ratio >1 is in favor of tenecteplase.
